Information About 5A & 5B

At a special meeting of the Jeffco Public Schools Board of Education on August 23, the board decided to place two initiatives on the 2018 ballot:

- **A mill levy override that would provide financial resources to support operations directly related to student learning and success**
- **A bond that would enable needed upgrades to our facilities**

If the ballot items pass, Ute Meadows would receive about **\$1,009,038 in facilities improvements from the bond, plus more funding for teachers/staff from the mill levy override. Please click on the link below for more information.**

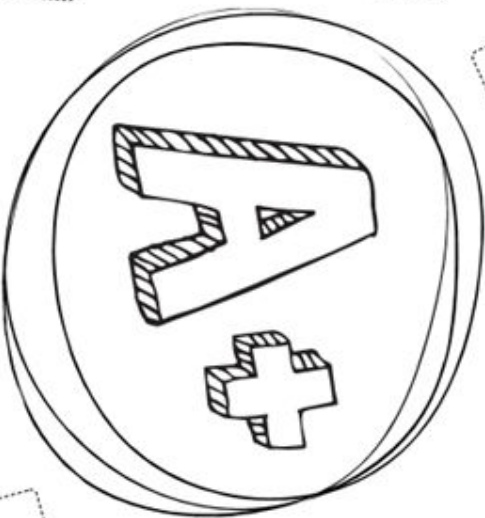
